Perform hand hygiene with alcohol-based hand sanitizer.	Don yellow disposable isolation gown with thumbs through thumb hooks. Tie waist ties behind the back.	Don fit-tested N95-respirator. Mold (do not pinch) the nosepiece to obtain a seal. Perform a seal check.	Don face shield or eye goggles. Personal eyeglasses are not adequate.	Don double gloves and pull over cuffs of gown. Remove outer glove after intubation.

How do I doff PPE in the OR?

STEP 5

Grab yellow isolation gown at waist and pull forward to break ties at back. Continue pulling forward to cause back of gown to tear away.

Roll gown into itself and peel off gloves at same time.
Only touch the **inside** of the gown and gloves.
Discard.

Remove face shield or eye goggles without touching your face. Do not touch the front of the face shield or eye goggles.

Remove N-95 respirator by lifting the bottom strap over your head and then lifting the top strap over your head.

Perform hand hygiene with alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
